

2025-2026 Academic Year (114th AY) General Education Course Achievement Recognition Awards

To enhance students' learning outcomes in general education courses and broaden their academic achievements, the selection for the 2025-2026 Academic Year General Education Course Achievement Recognition Awards has officially begun! We welcome everyone to participate enthusiastically!

I. Selection Timeline

1. **Registration Deadline: June 21, 2026 (Sunday) by 23:59.**
2. **Award Ceremony:** Winners will be notified separately when the award list is announced. **All awarded works must be displayed at the CCU Freshman Orientation and on the Center's website.** (Reference: [113th Academic Year Awarded Works](#))

II. Awards

A total of **20 teams** will be selected, with a prize of **NT\$3,000** per team. Awards will be determined by the selection committee based on the quality of participant works and the annual budget; if necessary, "awards may be withheld" or "additional awards may be granted".

III. Eligibility

1. **Target Participants:** Undergraduate students of National Chung Cheng University (CCU) who are enrolled in general education courses during the 2025-2026 academic year (**semesters 114-1 and 114-2**).
2. **Team Composition:** Cross-departmental teams are encouraged. Each team shall consist of **one to five** students.
3. **Restrictions:** Works that have already been registered for or received awards in other competitions may not be submitted for consideration to this event.

IV. Content and Rules

General Requirements: The work may include images and text, videos, or physical products. The file name must follow the format "**Team Name-Work Title**". Please submit works according to the following specifications:

1. Images and Text:

- **Production Specifications:** The work must be created in **vertical A1 size (594x841 mm)** (poster design recommended) with a resolution of **300 dpi or higher**, submitted as **JPG or PDF files**, with a limit of two pages.
- **Required Information:** Course title, team members, learning objectives, highlights of learning outcomes with photos, and reflections for improvement. If the required information cannot be fully presented on the poster, a "[Work and Learning Outcomes Report](#)" may be added as a supplement.

2. Videos:

- **Production Specifications:** Video length must be between **3 to 5 minutes**, in **MP4 format** with a resolution of **1080p or higher**.
- **Required Information:** The video must include **background music and subtitles**. Video content must include the work title, course title, team members, learning objectives, highlights of the learning outcomes, and focused reflection for improvement. If the required information cannot be fully presented in the video, a "[Work and Learning Outcomes Report](#)" may be added as a supplement.
- **Rights:** If visual materials involve others' creations or portrait rights, authorization must be obtained prior to use.
- **Music:** For music materials other than original compositions, music authorized under "Creative Commons (CC0, CCBY)" licenses may be used with proper citation; other legally authorized music may also be used.
- **Submission:** Videos must be uploaded to a personal cloud drive with a share link set to "**Anyone with the link can view**," and the link must be filled in on the registration form.

3. Physical Products:

- **Production Specifications:** Please provide a "Work and Learning Outcomes Report" along with the physical product (format unrestricted). The report should be between **4 to 10 pages** in length, excluding the cover. The main text should be in **12-point font with single line spacing** (title font is free choice).
- **Required Information:** The "Work and Learning Outcomes Report" must contain the course title, team members, learning objectives, work title, abstract, work photos, detailed explanations, and focused reflection for improvement.

Other Regulations:

- **AI Policy:** This selection activity may employ artificial intelligence (AI) tools for assistance. If AI is used to generate text or images, the software used, the scope of application, and the proportion of assistance must be clearly indicated at the point of use, and relevant authorization must be obtained.
- **Exhibition:** All awarded works will be displayed at CCU's orientation event for freshmen as arranged by the organizer.
- **Attendance:** At least one member of each award-winning team must attend the award ceremony for this recognition activity.
